

Assignment 12: Click and Hold to Paint with the Airbrush

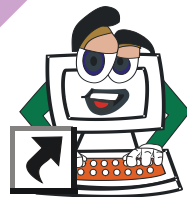
The *Airbrush* is much like painting with a "real" spray can of paint. The longer you spray over a spot, the more paint comes out. This makes the spot darker and darker.

Just like a "real" spray can you need to keep your finger on the button as you let go of the button.

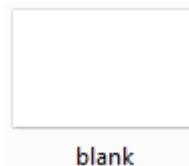
Explore digital paint tools to refine fine motor skills with TechnoPC.

Click and hold the mouse button to move the mouse pointer to *blank*.



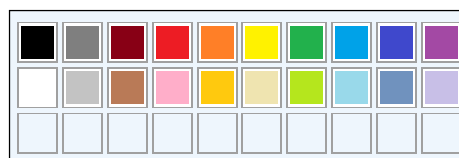
TIP: If the template does not open in Microsoft Paint, you will need to follow the instructions in the Preparing to Teach section that describe how to change the default program.

Click and hold the mouse button to **Double click** the mouse to open the template in Microsoft Paint.

Point and Click to Select a Color

Click and hold the mouse button to point the mouse to a color in the *Color Box*.

Click the left mouse button on a color square to select the color.



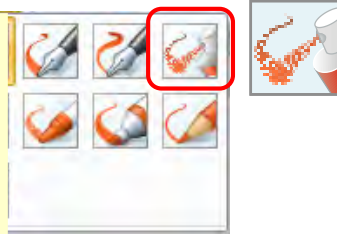
Click and Hold the Mouse Using the Airbrush

☞ From the gallery, click the *Airbrush*.

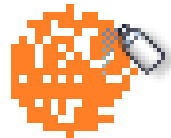
Microsoft Paint is free with your operating system!

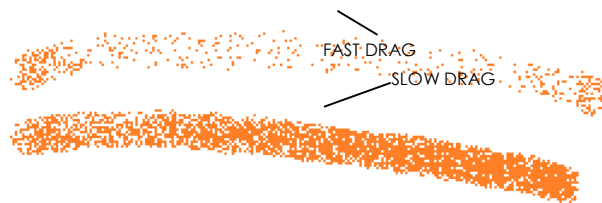


☞ **Click and hold** the mouse button. Keep the mouse in one spot.



☞ **Click and hold** the mouse button. Drag the mouse slowly.

☞ **Click and hold** the mouse button. Drag the mouse quickly.

Click and Drag to Draw a Text Box

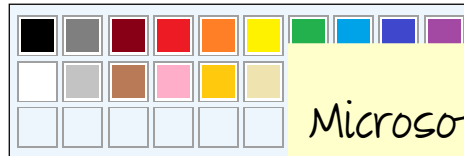
Click the *Text* tool.



Click and drag to draw a text box.



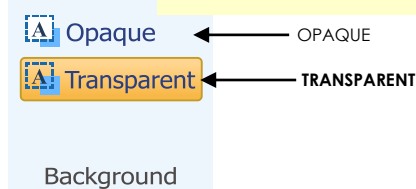
Choose a new color from the *Color Box*.

Click the *Transparent* option in the Background



Print the Picture

☞ Move the mouse pointer to the Paint button.



☞ **Click** the arrow.

☞ **Move** the mouse down the list and click *Print*.



☞ Click OK.

Exit Microsoft Paint

☞ **Point and click** the mouse pointer on the *Close* button (X).



☞ When asked to save changes, click **Don't Save**.
